

# BRAZOS ELECTRIC PUBLIC OPEN HOUSE MEETING

## PROPOSED PURDON-EMMETT 138 KV TRANSMISSION LINE UPGRADE PROJECT

### PROJECT OVERVIEW

Brazos Electric plans to upgrade approximately 10.5 miles of existing transmission line between Purdon Substation and the Emmett Substation in Navarro County, Texas. The existing 69 kilovolt (kV) single circuit line is more than 65 years old and has been recommended for improvements to support reliability, improve operational flexibility, and provide additional interconnection capacity for the region.

The upgraded line will be a 138 kV double circuit line constructed on single-pole steel or concrete structures, improving long-term resiliency for Brazos Electric and its member cooperatives. To maintain continuous service during construction, Brazos Electric will need to shift the transmission line centerline and acquire an additional 35 feet of easement adjacent to the current right-of-way. In some locations along the alignment, 100 to 150 feet of new easement may be required. The project also includes construction of a new switching station (Pursley Switch Station) across the street from the existing Purdon Substation.



### PROJECT DEVELOPMENT PROCESS

Brazos Electric will submit a proposed route to the Public Utility Commission of Texas (PUCT).

When the PUCT submittal takes place, Brazos Electric will notify affected landowners along the proposed route and provide information on how to be further involved in the transmission line review process at the PUCT.



### PUBLIC MEETING PURPOSE

The purpose of this meeting is for Brazos Electric to present information, answer your questions about the project, and receive your ideas and concerns. You will notice that there are several exhibits around the room. Representatives of Brazos Electric and Oaklight Environmental are available to answer questions about the proposed project.
